

SWIMMING



Term 4 - 2017

Our annual swimming programme at Huia Pool starts on **Monday, 16th October**, the first day back at school after the holidays. There will be 7 sessions run over 2 weeks: Monday to Thursday in Week 1 and Tuesday to Thursday in Week 2 as Monday, 23rd Oct is Labour Day. We will be using 4 swimming instructors, as well as class teachers to work with 2 classes at a time. The times and classes are as follows:

Rooms 3 and 9 children will leave school 9:40am and be in the pool from 10am – 10:30am.

Rooms 4 and 7 children will leave school at 10:10am and be in the pool from 10:30am – 11am.

Rooms 5 and 6 children will leave school at 10:40am and be in the pool from 11am – 11:30am.

Rooms 1, 2 and 8 children will leave school at 11:10am and be in the pool from 11:30am – 12pm.

The children will be travelling to and from the pool in a bus paid for by the BOT, who also pay for the pool entry for each child and for the instructors.

We suggest boys come to school in their togs, but it may be easier for the girls to bring their togs to school and change either at the pool, or just before we leave. Please make sure all clothing, towels and bags are named.

If your child is unable to swim on any of the days, please let their teacher know. If your child does not have their togs at school and we have not heard from you, they will be lent school togs and a towel for the day.

Parent Help

Rooms 1 & 2 need helpers in the pool between 11:30am & 12noon each day to work with small groups of children. We also appreciate help with dressing and undressing the children. Please let Mrs Riley or Mrs Dunstan Brown/Mrs Montgomery know by the end of this term, if you are able to help.

Goggles

It is recommended that all children wear goggles in the pool. These give children more confidence to put their faces in the water, open their eyes and see where they are going. We would appreciate it if you could make sure your child brings **named** goggles to school as part of their swimming gear.
